



Dr. Young-Hai PARK, Past Asia-Pacific Regional Coordinator of BPW International 2008-2011, is Emeritus Professor at Sookmyung Women's University with a Ph.D. from the University of Paris –Sorbonne 1971, Post-doctoral Scholar at UCLA 1976, Visiting Scholar at Harvard University, 1990. She served as Dean of the College of Liberal Arts 1996-2000, Director of Research Center for Asian Women 1979, and President of many associations including Societe Coreenne de Langue et Litterature Francaises 2006 and Korean Association of Women's Studies 1986, which she helped building as founding Vice-President and the President during the first three years. Her interests and leadership in womens's issues, made her a driving force for the promotion of women's status, in particular, through the Korean Women's NGO Network created for Beijing in advocating an Ad-hoc Committee and later on a standing Committee on Women at the National Assembly, and the Basic Act for Women's Development. On the other hand, as President of BPW Korea, she created BPW Gold Award in 1993 and purchased the National Office of BPW Korea as a legal entity. Since she joined BPW as a Charter President of a club in Seoul in 1974, she showed her devotion and commitment to promote women's empowerment on national and international levels. She served ICW as Vice-President, APWW Steering Committee Member, APEC Women Leaders Network, etc. She received merits « Commandeur des Palmes Academiques », French Government (2008), Green Medal Merits of President of the Republic of Korea (2008),
