Miss Thitinan Wattanavekin was Former Finance Director of BPW International from 2005 to 2008. Her contribution was to modernize BPW International's accounting system with consistency in reporting routine. Currently, she is Vice President of BPW Thailand from 2014 to 2018 who is also in charge as chairperson for BPW Thailand's financial literacy project that aims to promote fundamental financial discipline among youths and employed people across the country. Moreover, she has prominent role in encouraging members of BPW Thailand to apply their business and professional expertise to help society in other fields too.

Miss Thitinan is a well-known banker in Thailand. In 1997, she was a member of the Board of Directors of Kiatnakin Finance and Securities Co., Ltd., one of 58 local financial institutions that were forced to temporarily suspend operations due to global economic crisis. With her and other members of the Board's contribution, the company was one of two financial institutions granted permission by the Ministry of Finance to resume business operations in 1998. Then, it was upgraded to become a commercial bank under the name "Kiatnakin Bank Plc." in 2005 and she was a member of top management team before joining the Bank's Board of Directors from 2011 till now.

Miss Thitinan has had long experiences in charitable works from her childhood days. She has been appointed to be in charge of Kiatnakin Bank's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). Under her leadership, the Bank has received "Outstanding CSR Awards" in 2012-2014 and "Thailand Sustainability Investment Awards" from 2015-2017 by the Stock Exchange of Thailand caused by its outstanding performance in environment, society, and good governance fields. Furthermore, Miss Thitinan is Chairperson of CSR Club under the Thai Bankers' Association whose members comprises CSR executives and staff from 15 local commercial banks to work on CSR projects, in particular concerning the promotion of financial literacy in the country. She is also Vice Chairperson of Kiatnakin Foundation that works closely with Kiatnakin Bank to extend social responsibility roles into wider society.
